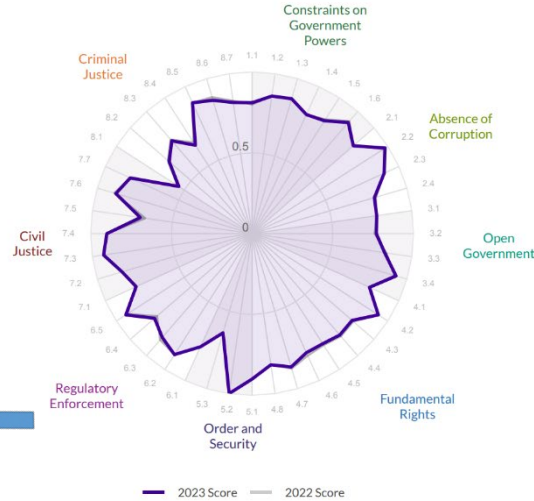

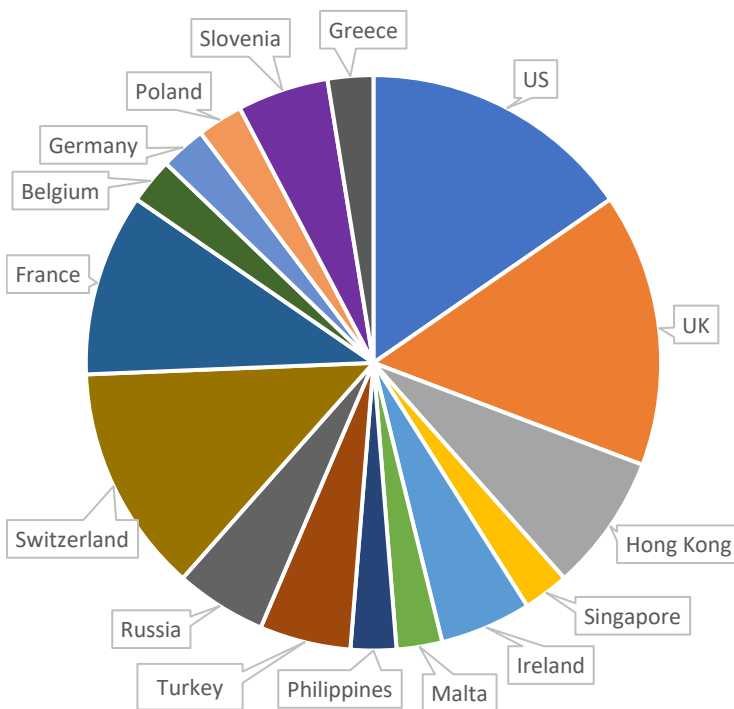

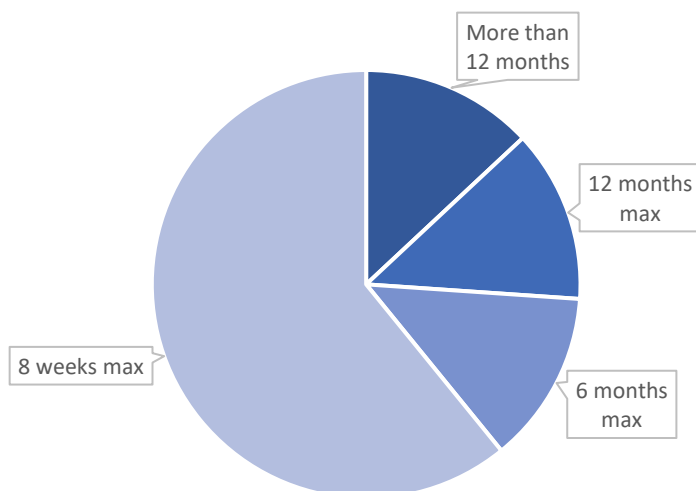
Inauguration	1 January 2019
