What does the district judge do?

The district judge handles small court cases of residents from the Geuzenveld-Slotermeer neighbourhood. District judges also conduct interviews to prevent lawsuits.

The district judge believes that problems are there to be solved. The district judge discusses with all people involved how problems can be addressed and who will help. In the discussions with the district judge, those involved decide what arrangements will be made. In the court case, the district judge decides what needs to happen.

This is why you come to the district judge

Option 1

You receive a summons from the court. This could be in any of the following situations:

- If your child does not attend school
- If you do not pay health insurance or rent
- If you are suspected of a minor offence

Option 2

You request a solution-oriented conversation yourself. This could be in any of the following situations:

- A conflict between family members or (ex-)partners that you want to resolve and agree on together.
- If you are in a support programme and you and your case worker feel that a judge is needed to move forward together in a good way or to better address your problems.
